TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE GENERAL STATEMENT

In these conditions: -

The seller means Meatex Trading Ltd

The buyer means the person, firm or company purchasing the goods

The Goods means the goods which shall be the subject of the contract between the Seller and the Buyer.

1.WARRANTY

The seller warrants to the buyer that the Goods supplied are of the nature, substance, quality and quantity described and that they conform in every respect with the requirements of the Foods Acts and all statutory regulations and provisions applicable to such goods.

2. COMPLAINTS

- (a) The Buyer shall be under an obligation to examine and inspect the Goods upon delivery for correct weight, defects to and or loss or damage to the same.
- (b) The Buyer shall report to the Seller any apparent short weight in any Goods within 24 hours of delivery and must confirm the same in writing to the Seller within three days of delivery. The Goods must be available for inspection by the Seller. In the event of non-compliance with this requirement the Seller shall not be liable in any circumstances under contract, tort or otherwise in respect of any defect and or damage and/or consequential loss arising therefrom.
- (c) The Buyer shall report to the Seller any defects to and or loss or damage to the Goods in the case of fresh goods within 24 hours of delivery and in the case of frozen goods within one week of delivery and in either such case the Goods must be available for inspection by the Seller. In the event of non-compliance with this requirement the Seller shall not be liable in any circumstances under the contract, tort or otherwise in respect of any defect and/or damage and/or consequential loss arising therefrom.

3. TITLE

- (a) The Goods are at Buyer's risk from the time of delivery to the Buyer
- (b) Title to all Goods supplied by the Seller to the Buyer shall remain in the Seller until payment in full has been made. Until that time the relationship between the parties shall be that of bailor and bailee. So long as the Buyer remains bailee of any of the Goods it shall keep those Goods separate from any goods which are the property of the Buyer or any Third Party.
